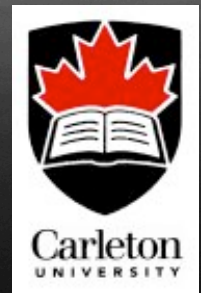

The Idea: We are developing a **Cluster for Evidence-Based Conservation and Environmental Management**. The first of its kind in Canada, the program will support the training of highly qualified students for careers outside of academia. We will specialize in conducting **systematic reviews** to support decision making by evaluating the best-available scientific evidence.

Involvement: Led by **Dr. Steven Cooke**, a group of research scientists and policy specialists from academia and natural resource agencies will develop the program at **Carleton University**. We are modeling our efforts after the highly successful centre led by Dr. Andrew Pullin, CEBC (Center for Evidence-Based Conservation) in Bangor University, Wales.

How to Register: We are hosting a **free workshop** that is open to anyone interested in learning about systematic reviews and the Cluster. Dr. Neal Haddaway from the CEBC will graciously join us to run through the systematic review process on Jan 30th.
